9. The rates quoted by the contractor shall include all applicable taxes, octroi, tpt, loading/unloading and labour charges. Rates will be valid for minimum 180 days.

10. Last date of receipt of sealed tenders duly completed is 1000 hrs on 01 Jan 2024. All bids received after 1000 hrs on 01 Jan 2024 shall be considered invalid and shall not be opened. Tenders will be opened by the Board of Officers at 1200 hrs on 01 Jan 2024.

3. **Scope of Work.** Upgradation/renovation of car and cycle parking with hardstanding, repair of Front wall with two entrance gates and fencing with sheds (view cutter) for car and cycles as per specification and drawing given duly completed in all respect at Army Public School, Ambala Cantt as a framed structure as per specification, dimensions given, details specified and directed.

Detailed Specifications

4. Details of work are as under:-
- (a) Repair of front boundary wall - Approx 250 Ft
- (b) 02 x Gates should be of good quality (A1 quality material) and with min 12 Ft width and have good space for the students while going to and fro of the gate. Details of gates are as under.
- (i) 01 x Gate with arch for Teachers four wheeler
- (ii) 01 x Gate with arch for students cycle.
- (c) Teacher's Parking
- (i) Hard standing – 11000 Sq Ft
- (ii) 02 x Car Parking Shed (15' x 90' and 15' x 30')
- (d) Students Parking
- (i) Hard standing – 10000 Sq Ft
- (ii) 03 x Cycle Parking Shed (90' x 12' each with 12 Ft Height)
- (e) View cutter of boundary wall - 600 Running Ft.

5. In super structure brick work will be laid in cement sand mortar 1:4 for 9" thick walls
6. Plastering of both internal and external walls shall be done in cement sand mortar of ratio 1:4.
7. Hardstanding Flooring. Earth filling inside foundation shall be leveled and compacted with watering and rolling in layers not exceeding 250mm over which a 100mm thick PCC sub-base 1:4:8 with 40mm graded stone aggregate will be provided. Thereafter, a 80mm thick screed bed with cement sand mortar of 1:2:4 shall be provided. Flooring shall be done over this surface using crusher
8. Existing old material be used only if it has a strength to work for long time for wall repair.
9. Construction should be as per drawing given.
10. Galvanised shed with 50mm square pipe (18 Kgs) for Truss and 50mm square(18 Kgs and 1S1Mark) Pirlins for supporting of sheets at the distance of 1 mtr area from centre to centre 50 mm Square dia (12 Kgs). 2 Inch ISI marked Round pipe will be used for vertical support of Trusses. Pipe will be grouted 2 Ft under ground level and 12 Ft height above ground level. All pipes should be of ISI mark.
11. Colour of Galvanised sheet be specified by school authorities and 2'-0" to be kept outside the dice area. Thickness of Galvanised sheet will be min 0.5 mm or as specified by school.
12. Ultra Tech/Gujrat Ambuja cement of 53 OPC or higher grade shall only be used.
13. Samples of all fitment items will be provided and approved before commencement of work.
14. The structure shall be constructed strictly as directed and specified as per pathways. However, there shall not be any change in the scope of work from what has been mentioned in this document.
15. In case of any ambiguity on any aspect related to the construction of the structure, The National Building Code shall be taken as the guiding document.
16. Time for completion of the work shall be **30 days** from the date of issue of work order for commencement of the work.
17. Date of completion shall be the date on which completion certificate is issued to the contractor which shall only be done after rectification of defects; if any pointed out by the accepting officer of the contract/his representative to the contractor upon receipt of written confirmation of work completion from the contractor.

18. No sub-letting of any part or portion of the work shall be permitted and it shall be the sole responsibility of the contractor undertaking the work to complete the work within time.
19. No advance payment shall be made and the payment shall be made on completion of said work.
20. The rates quoted by the contractor shall include all applicable taxes, octroi, transportation, loading/unloading and labour charges. No additional payment other than what has been quoted for in the tender shall be payable to the contractor under any circumstances.
21. The Accepting Officer reserves the right to modify/add/reduce the scope of work due to site or functional requirements which shall be binding on the contractor to execute with appropriate financial effect if any as per existing market rates in Ambala.
22. Electricity and water charges at rates charged by govt agencies shall be deducted from the payment due to the contractor for the units consumed by the contractor for execution of work.
23. The rates quoted shall be valid for a period of 180 days from the date of opening of the financial bid.
24. The contractor shall employ only Indian Nationals as he representatives, servants and workmen and ensure their police verification to verify their antecedents and loyalty before employing them for work and shall satisfy the Principal APS as to their bonafides.
25. The contractor shall take all steps to avoid any damage, mis-happening, accident etc to the workmen engaged by him to carry out the work and school will have no responsibility in this regards
26. Accepting officer reserves the right to resort to re-tender incase the rates quoted are found to be unreasonable.
27. Last date of receipt of sealed tenders duly completed is 1000 hrs on 01 Jan 2024. All bids received after 01 Jan 2024 (1000 h) shall be considered invalid and shall not be opened
28. Bidders shall be deemed to have read, understood and willing to abide by this document when they submit their bids. **Accordingly, this form duly signed on each page with office stamp of the firm shall be submitted alongwith the bid documents; failing which the bid shall be considered invalid and no cognizance shall be taken of it.**
