22. **Franking Clause.** The following Franking clause will form part of the contract placed on successful Bidder:-

(a) **Franking Clause in Case of Acceptance of Eqpts**. "The fact that the eqpts have been inspected after the delivery period and passed by the Inspecting Officer will not have the effect of keeping the contract alive. The eqpts are being passed without prejudice to the rights of the Buyer under the terms and conditions of the contract".

- 3. <u>Time Line for completion of Project</u> -Even though the overall completion period is indicated as **Ninety days**, the work shall be completed progressively and handed over as per agreed split up schedule if any.
- 4. The tenderers are advised to visit the site and get themselves acquainted with the site conditions before submitting the offer.
- 5. Quoted rate shall remain valid for a period of 180 days from the date of tender opening for the release of work order and will be firm throughout the contract period of **One Hundred Eighty days** or till completion of work, once awarded and no cost escalation is allowed on any account.
- 6. The item rate offered is for finished item of works and shall provide for the complete cost towards fuel, tools, tackles, plant & machinery, temporary works, labour, materials, levies, taxes, transport, lay-out, repairs, rectifications, maintenance till handing over, supervision, labour colonies, establishment, services, roads, revenue expenses, overheads, profits & all other incidentals etc., complete. Rate quoted shall include GST.

The Tenderer should be a GST Registered Contractor and should have filed returns with respect to GST and proof of documents should be furnished (Minimum last 05 GST returned filled to be attached). - 47. If the tenderer deliberately gives wrong information in his tender or creates conditions favorable for the acceptance of his tender, Army Public School, Ambala Cantt reserves the right to reject such tender at any stage.
- 48.The expenses for completing and stamping the agreement shall be paid by the contractor.

49.Tenderers shall not increase their quoted rate in case Army Public School, Ambala Cantt negotiates for reduction of rate. Such negotiation shall not amount to cancellation or withdrawal of the original offer and the rate originally quoted shall be binding on the tenderers for a period of six months from the date of opening of tenders.

50. Canvassing in any form in connection with tenders is strictly prohibited and the tenderssubmitted by the contractors who resort to canvassing will be liable to rejection

51. All entries in the tender documents should be in one ink. Erasers and over writings are not permitted. All cancellations and insertions should be duly attested by the tenderer concerned.

52. TENDERERS should fill in all the required particulars in the blank spaces provided for this purpose in the tender documents and also sign each and every page of Tender Documents including the drawings attached there to, before submitting their tender.

53. Conditional and Unwitnessed tenders, tender containing absurd rates and amounts tenders which are incomplete or otherwise considered defective and tenders not in accordance with the tender conditions laid down by the Accepting Officer are liable to be rejected.

54. Tenders not submitted on the prescribed form are liable to be rejected.

55. This tender notice shall be deemed to form an integral part of the contract to be entered

into for this work.

Proprietor/Partner of The Firm

- 56. The tenderers are advised to go through the condition stipulated in Tender document &code of conduct for Safety of Contract Labourer in details. Any violation thereof will invite punitive action being taken against them. While quoting the rate all the above factors are to be taken into account.
- 57. Agency registered with NSIC is exempted from payment of tender document cost & Earnest Money Deposit but to submit security deposit. They are required to attach the attested copy of registration indicating the company name, address, registration number, validity & product for which registered in the technical bid,. Any deviation in the certificate on product or validity or name of the company tendering, will attract rejection resulting non-opening of respective price bid.

58. Compensation for Delay:

If the contractor fails to maintain the required progress or to complete the work and clear the site on or before the contracted or extended period of completion, he shall, without prejudice to any other right or remedy of the Army Public School, Ambala Cantt on account of such breach, pay as agreed compensation an amount calculated as stipulated below or such smaller amount as may be fixed by the Army Public School, Ambala Cantt on the contract value of the work for every week that the progress remains below or that the work remains incomplete. This will also apply to items or group of items for which separate period of completion has been specified.

For this purpose the term 'Contract Value' shall be the value at contract rates of the work as ordered and the compensation for delay is by way of recovery at 1 percent of contract value per week of delay provided always that the total amount of compensation for delay to be paid under this condition shall not exceed 10% of the contract value or of the contract value of the item or group of items of work for which a separate period of completion is given.

The amount of compensation may be adjusted or set-off against any sum payable to the Contractor under this or any other contract with the Army Public School, Ambala Cantt.

59.Arbitration:

Except where otherwise provided for in the contract all questions and disputes relating to the meaning of the specifications, designs, drawings and instructions hereinbefore mentioned and as to the quality of workmanship or materials used on the work or as to any other question, claim, right, matter or thing whatsoever in any way arising out of or relating to the contract, designs, drawings, specifications, estimates, instructions, orders or these conditions or otherwise concerning the work or failure to execute the same whether arising during the progress of the work or after the completion or abandonment thereof shall be referred to the sole arbitration of the Chairman of Army Public School, Ambala Cantt and if Chairman is unable or unwilling to act, to the sole arbitrator. The cases referred to arbitration shall be other than those for which the decision of the Engineer-in-charge is expressed in the contract to be final and conclusive. There will be no objection if the arbitrator so appointed is an employee of Army Public School, Ambala Cantt and that he had to deal with the matters to which the contract relates and

that in the course of his duties as such he had expressed views on all or any of the matters in dispute or difference.

Proprietor/Partner of The Firm_____

The arbitrator to whom the matter is originally referred being transferred or vacating his office or being unable to act for any reason, Chairman as aforesaid at the time of such transfer, vacation of office or inability to act, shall appoint another person to act as arbitrator in accordance with the terms of the contract. Such person shall be entitled to proceed with the reference from the stage at which it was left by his predecessor. Subject as aforesaid the provision of the Arbitration & Reconciliation Act, 1996 or any statutory modification or re-enactment thereof and the rules made there under and for the time being in force shall apply to the arbitration proceeding under this clause.

It is a term of the contract that the party involving arbitration shall specify the dispute or disputes to be referred to arbitration under this clause together with the amount or amounts claimed in respect of each such dispute. The arbitrator(s) may from time to time with consent of the parties enlarge the time for making and publishing the award.

The work under the Contract shall, if reasonably possible, continue, during the arbitration proceedings and no payment due or payable, to the Contractor shall be withheld on account of such proceeding.

The Arbitrator shall be deemed to have entered on the reference on the date he issues notice to both the Parties fixing the date of first hearings. The arbitrator shall give a separate award in respect of each dispute or difference referred to him. The venue of arbitration shall be such place as may be fixed by the Arbitrator in his sole discretion. The award of the arbitrator shall be final, conclusive and binding on all parties to this contract.

In the event of disputes or differences arising between one public sector enterprise and a Govt. Department or between two public sector enterprises the above stipulations shall not apply or its amendments for arbitration shall be applicable.

59. Force Majeure clause:

If at any time during the continuance of this contract the performance in whole or in part by either party of any obligations under this contract shall be prevented or delayed by reason, of any war, hostilities, acts of the public enemy, civil commotion, sabotage, fires, explosions, epidemics, guarantine, restrictions or acts of GOD (hereinafter referred to as events) then provided notice of happening of any such events is given by either party to other within twenty one days from the date of occurrence thereof neither party shall reason of such events be entitled to terminate this contract nor shall either party have any such non-performance and delay is resumed as soon as practicable after such events has come to an end or ceased to exist. If the performance in whole or part of any obligation under this contract is prevented or delayed by reason or any such event claims for extension of time shall be granted for period considered reasonable by Army Public School, Ambala Cantt subject to prompt notification by the tenderer to Army Public School, Ambala Cantt of the particulars of the events and supply to the Army Public School, Ambala Cantt if required of any supporting evidence. Any waiver of time in respect of partial installment shall not be deemed to be a waiver of time in respect of remaining deliveries.

CONTRACTOR

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The correspondence exchanged against the tender from both tenderer and Army Public School, Ambala Cantt through email are considered as valid document legally though it is not signed. It is treated as valid confirmations made on behalf of the respective company and very much comes under the legal ambit of the business transaction and hence it is binding on boththe parties to the business.

Any transaction pertaining to the tender from both the parties of business done round the clock irrespective of the office or business hours of the companies, are valid legally and binding on both the parties. This applies to the extent only in such cases where deadline time for transaction is not specifically declared by either or both the patties to the business.

In case Letter of Intent (LOI) is issued through email, the PC generated time and date of mail shall be construed as the official time and date of release of LOI. In as much as this date is within the last date of validity given by the tenderer the LOI is said to have been issued within the validity period and shall be bidding on both the parties to the business.

Tenderers participating in the tender should declare in their technical bid that whether they have been black-listed / kept on hold for a specified period / given Business holiday for a specified period by any Public sector undertaking or Government departments. The reasons for such action with details and the current status of such hold shall be clearly furnished to Army Public School, Ambala Cantt. If no such details are mentioned in the offer then it will be construed that the subject tenderer is not under any such hold. But at a later date if it comes to the notice of Army Public School, Ambala Cantt about any such hold under enforcement on the subject tenderer, Army Public School, Ambala Cantt will have every right to reject the offer of such vendors at any point of time and also under any stage of the finalisation of the subject tender irrespective of the status of the subject tenderer in that tender. Such tenderers will not be permitted to participate in the further tender proceedings and will be communicated suitably. They will not be also considered for any ongoing tenders even if participated till I the hold is officially lifted and confirmed in writing.

GENERAL CONDITIONS OF CONTRACT

- 1. No night work will be permitted without the written permission of the Army Public School, Ambala Cantt.
- 2. Permission for erection of temporary work sheds etc., at site will have to be obtained from Army Public School, Ambala Cantt in writing in advance.
- 3. The works contract to be entered into with the successful tenderer will be governed as per the directions of the Army Public School, Ambala Cantt
- 4. The successful tenderer / Contractor shall observe all safety regulations and take necessary safety precaution as called for and Safety Precautions enclosed herewith.
- 5. In all matters of dispute, the decision of the chairman, Army Public School, Ambala Cantt Shall be final and binding on the tenderer / contractor.
- 6. Some changes are likely in the quantities furnished as well as in the layout, design and specifications of the work. The rate quoted shall be deemed to be inclusive of all such contingencies.
- 7. All the materials to be used in the work and nature of work shall conform to respective BIS and National Buildings Organisation Standard Specifications and shall be got approved by the Army Public School, Ambala Cantt through PMG before actual incorporation in the work.
- 8. All materials brought by the Contractor for incorporation in the work shall be got inspected and approved by the Army Public School, Ambala Cantt through PMG before they are incorporated in thework
- 9. Engineer in charge / Civil or PMG representative shall have all reasonabletimes access to Contractor's premises of work and shall have the power at all the reasonable times to inspect and test any portion of the work or examine the materials and workmanship of the structures during their manufacture and test. The contractor shall give due notice in writing to the PMG committee and Army Public School, Ambala Cantt when the materials supplied to be incorporated in the work are ready for Inspection and test. No material shall be incorporated in the work until PMG committee certified in writing that such materials have been inspected and approved by him or else the rejected material should be removed from site immediately.
- 10. The Contractor shall closely scrutinize all the drawings issued in connection with the work by this organization and bring to the notice of the PMG if any discrepancies, omissions in the drawings before undertaking the actual work pertaining thereto.
- 11. <u>Progress of work</u> The contractor should submit in advance every fortnight a detailed programme of workto be undertaken from time to time strictly in conformities with the "Time and Progress Chart" covering the entire constructed work and reschedule them wherever necessaryduring the progress of the work so as to achieve the target set.

12. The contractor should extend full co-operation to the other contractors who may be doing other works in the same areas to enable them to execute their portions of work without any delay or difficulty.

GENERAL SAFETY PRECAUTIONS TO BE FOLLOWED AT WORK SITE DURING EXECUTION

The following safety measures should be strictly adhered to, during execution of works at sites.

- 1. Providing the working platform with toe board and handrail for continuous working at heights.
- 2. Providing safety belt and life line at all times for men working at heights.
- 3. Providing dust or fume respirator in places where dust and fume concentration exists.
- 4. Providing goggles and welding screens.
- 5. Providing acid and alkali proof rubber gloves for handling acid and alkali and Chemical which are corrosive.
- 6. Providing rubber gloves for working on electrical works.
- 7. Ensuring proper lashing of the components while being transported in vehicles.
- 8. The vehicles must have side supports or have body to support the materials Conveyed.
- 9. The materials should not be allowed to extend or overflow the sides of the vehicles.
- 10. Materials should not be allowed to overhang from the rear edge of the body of the Vehicle.
- 11. Driver of the vehicle must possess license.
- 12. Vehicle must not be overloaded prescribed limits.
- 13. Red flags and lights for parts projecting from the body of vehicle must be provided.
- 14. The speed restrictions within the Institute must be strictly adhered to.
- 15. The gas cylinders must be always handled on trolleys or kept tied down not in use. They should never be rolled as Roller for conveying.
- 16. Cylinders should not be used without regulators.

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CONTRACTOR

- 17. All excavations must be barricaded and red lamps must be provided.
- 18. All electrical connections must be properly earthed.
- 19. Providing helmet, safety belt, etc., for high level work and sufficient number of Industrial Safety nets at appropriate level to safeguard the persons working at high level particularly in roofing etc.,
- 20. All personal protective equipment conform with standard specification and Contractor including their sub-contractors, agents and labour engaged on the work are required to scrupulously adhere to the safety regulations, safety precautions and measurers. Any violation thereof will invite punitive action being taken against them. Also contractors with frequent violations of safety regulations will not be entrusted with further work in this organization.

SAFETY PRECAUTIONS TO BE OBSERVED WHILE TRANSPORTING MATERIALS

I. VEHICLE

Vehicles carrying material should have proper registration documents and must be produced on demand by our Security Staff.

The light on right side, i.e., over the driver's cabin shall be in working condition.

Both the head lights as well as park lamps must be in working conditions.

II. MOVEMENT OF VEHICLE

- 1. The vehicle should not travel at more than 20 km.ph in our premises.
- 2. The Driver of the vehicle must possess heavy duty license and produce on demand by the Security Staff.
- 3. Vehicles carrying inflammable liquids in the tank containers should have grounding Chain or the tank should be coated with insulating material also to avoid Static Electricity.
- 4. In road junctions, speed breakers and railway crossing, the speed should be lowered and vehicle should proceed cautiously.
- 5. The driving should 'KEEP TO THE LEFT' at all places.
- 6. The vehicle should not be parked in road which could obstruct the vehicular traffic.
- 7. No person other than driver should be allowed to sit or stand on the prime mover or trailer.

- 8. The vehicle should pass only through the approved routes. Short cuts should be forbidden.
- 9. There must be a safe distance behind another moving truck.
- 10. The driver should avoid making quick starts, jerky stops or quick turns at excessive speed.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS REGARDING COMPLIANCE WITH VARIOUS LABOUR LAWS BY THE CONTRACTORS FOR ARMY PUBLIC SCHOOL, AMBALA CANTT

- 1. The Contractor shall not employ in connection with the work any person who has not completed 18 years of age.
- 2. The Contractor shall in respect of labour employed by him either directly or through Subcontractors comply with or cause to be complied with the following statutory provisions and rules and in regard to all matters provided therein.
 - a) The Contract Labour (Regulation & Abolition) Act 1970
 - b) The Minimum Wages Act 1948 and related Central Rules.
 - c) The Payment of Wages Act 1936 and related Central Rules.
 - d) The Employee's Provident Fund & Miscellaneous Provisions Act 1952.
 - e) The Employees State Insurance Act 1948.
 - f) The Workmen Compensation Act 1923.
 - g) The Industrial Disputes Act 1947.
 - h) The payment of bonus act 1965

And any other law or modifications to the above or to the Rules made hereunder from time to time.

- 3. The Contractor employing 20 or more workmen is required to obtain license from the authorities (The Deputy Chief Inspector of Factories / Assistant Commissioner of Labour as the case may be). The license shall be amended and / or renewed Wherever, there is an increase in the workmen employed by him or in the event of Contract being extended or renewed. The Contractor shall inform the license number to the Army Public School, Ambala Cantt before taking up the work.
- 4. The Contractor (Licensed or unlicensed) shall promptly furnish every information and document required by Army Public School, Ambala Cantt authorities for the purpose of fulfilling their Obligations as Principal Employer and shall render all necessary assistance for thesame.

WAGES

- 5. The Contractor shall pay wages to the workmen employed by him at the rate which shall not be less than the minimum wages applicable under Law from time to time.
- 6. The Contractor shall fix wage periods in respect of which wages shall be payable. No wage period shall exceed one month.

- 7. The Contractor shall ensure payment of wages to the contract labour employed by him within three days from the end of wage period in case the wage period is one week or a fortnight and in all other cases before **7t**h day of the following month.
- 8. All Payment of wages shall be made on working days at the work site and during the working time and on date notified in advance. In case the work is completed before the expiry of the wage period final payment shall be made within 48 hours of the last working day.
- 9. Where the employment of any worker is terminated by or on behalf of the Contractor, the wages earned by him shall be paid before the expiry of the second working day from the day on which his employment is terminated.
- 10. Wages due to every worker shall be paid to him direct or to the person authorized by him in this behalf. All wages shall be paid in current coin or currency in both.

POST TECHNICAL AUDIT OF WORK AND BILLS:-

11. Army Public School, Ambala Cantt reserves the right to carry out the post-payment Audit and technical examination of the work and final bill including all supporting vouchers, abstractsetc., and enforce recovery of any sum becoming due as a result thereof in themanner provided in the presiding sub-paragraphs. Such recovery shall be enforcedany time even after passing the final bill.

SUBMISSION OF BILLS BY CONTRACTOR: -

12. The Contractor at the end of each stage of work will submitte the bill for payment alongwith the photographs.

PAYMENT OF BILLS:-

13. All payments to be made to the Contractor, under this contract shall be by NEFT or RTGS within a reasonable time, after the certification of bills by the execution department.

RECOVERY FROM CONTRACTOR:-

14. Whenever under the contract, any sum of money, shall be recoverable from or payable by the Contractors, the same may be deducted from or any sum then due or which at any time thereafter may become due to Contractor under the contract or under any other contract with Army Public School, Ambala Cantt or from his Security Deposit or he shall pay theclaim on demand.

CANCELLATION OF CONTRACT FOR CORRUPT ACTS:-

15. Army Public School, Ambala Cantt, whose decision shall be final and conclusive, shall without prejudice to anyother right or remedy which shall have accrued shall accrue thereafter to Army Public School, Ambala Cantt cancel the contract in any of the following cases and the Contractor shall be liable to make payment to Army Public School, Ambala Cantt for any loss or damage resulting from any such cancellation to the same extent as provided in the case of cancellation for default,

If the Contractor shall:-

a) Offer or give or agree to give to any person in Army Public School, Ambala Cantt service any gift or consideration of any kind, as an inducement or reward for doing or for bearing to door for having done or for borne to do any act, in relation to the obtaining or execution of this or any other contract for Army Public School, Ambala Cantt service,

OR

b) Enter in to a contract with Army Public School, Ambala Cantt in connection with which commission has been paid or agreed to be paid by him or with his knowledge, unless the particulars of anysuch commission and the terms of payment thereof have previously been disclosed in writing to Army Public School, Ambala Cantt.

OR

c) Obtain a contract with Army Public School, Ambala Cantt as a result of ring tendering or by non-bonafide methods of competitive tendering, without first disclosing the fact in writing to Army Public School, Ambala Cantt.

CANCELLATION OF CONTRACT FOR INSOLVENCY ASSIGNMENT OF TRANSFER OR SUB-LETTING OF CONTRACT:-

16. Army Public School, Ambala Cantt, without prejudice to any other right or remedy which shall have accrued or Shall accrue thereafter to Army Public School, Ambala Cantt shall cancel the contract in any of the followingcases:

If the Contractor,

(a) Being an individual or if a firm any partner thereof shall at any time be adjudged bankrupt or have a receiving order for administration of his estate, made against him or shall take any proceedings for liquidation or composition under any bankruptcy Act or assignment of his effects of composition or arrangement for the benefit of his creditors or purport to do so, or if any application made under any

Bankruptcy Act for the time being in force for the sequestration of his estate or if a trust deed be granted by him on behalf of his creditors

OR

(b) Being a Company, shall pass a resolution or the Court shall make an order for the liquidation of its affairs, or a receiver or Manager on-behalf of the debenture holders shall be appointed or circumstances shall arise which entitle the Court or debenture holders to appoint a receiver or Manager,

- (c) Assigns, Transfers, Sub-lets or attempts to assign, transfer or sub-let any portion of the work without the prior written approval of the Army Public School, Ambala Cantt.
- (d) Army Public School, Ambala Cantt exercise the authority to cancel the contract under this conditions, Army Public School, Ambala Cantt may have the work done by any means at the Contractor's risksand expenses provided always that in the event of the cost of the work so done (ascertified by Engineer in charge which is final and conclusive) being less than the contract cost, the advantage shall accrue to the Army Public School, Ambala Cantt and if the cost exceeds themoney due to Contractor under the contract, the Contractor shall either pay the excess amount ordered by Army Public School, Ambala Cantt. or the same shall be recovered from the Contractor by other means.
- (e) In case the Army Public School, Ambala Cantt carries-out the work under the provisions of this condition the cost to be taken into account in determining the excess cost to be charged to the Contractor under this condition shall consist of the cost of the materials, hire chargesof tools and plants and/or labour provided by the Army Public School, Ambala Cantt with an addition of suchpercentage to cover superintendence and establishment charges as may bedecided by Estate Maintenance Dept., whose decision shall be final and conclusive.

CANCELLATION OF CONTRACT IN PART OF FULL FOR CONTRACATOR'S DEFAULT:

17. If the Contractor:

- (a) makes default in carrying out the work as directed and continues in that state after a reasonable notice from Engineer in charge or his authorised representative
- (b) fails to comply with any of the Terms and Conditions of the contract or after reasonable notice in writing with orders properly issued there under.

(c) Army Public School, Ambala Cantt may without prejudice to any other right or remedy which shall have accrued or shall accrue thereafter to Army Public School, Ambala Cantt, CANCEL the contract as whole or in part thereof or only such work order or items of work in default from the contract. Whenever Army Public School, Ambala Cantt exercise the authority to cancel the contract as whole or part under this condition Army Public School, Ambala Cantt may complete the work at the contractor's risk and cost (as certified by Army Public School, Ambala Cantt, which is final and conclusive) being less than the contract cost, the advantage shall accrue to the Army Public School, Ambala Cantt. If the cost exceeds the moneys due to the Contractor under this contract the Contractor shall either pay the excess amount ordered by Estate Maintenance Dept. or the same shall be recovered from the Contractor by other means. In case the Army Public School, Ambala Cantt carries out the work or any part thereof under the provisions of the conditions the cost to be taken into account in determining the excess cost to be charged to the Contractor under this condition shall consist of the cost of the materials, hire charges of tools and plant and/or labour provided by the Army Public School, Ambala Cantt with an addition of such percentage to cover the superintendence and establishment charges as may be decided by the Army Public School, Ambala Cantt, whose decision shall be final and conclusive.

TERMINATION OF CONTRACT ON DEATH OF CONTRACTOR. :-

18. Without prejudice to any of the rights or remedies under this contract, if the Contractor dies, or if the firm is dissolved or the company is liquidated, Army Public School, Ambala Cantt Y shallhave the option of terminating the contract without compensation to the Contractor.

SPECIAL POWER TO TERMINATION:-

19. If at any time after the award of contract, Army Public School, Ambala Cantt shall for any reason whatsoever not require whole or any part of the work to be carried out the Engineer in charge shall give notice in writing of the fact to the Contractor who shall have no claim toany payment of compensation or otherwise howsoever on account of any profit oradvantage which he might have derived from the execution of the work in full butwhich he did not derive in consequence of the fore-closing of the work.

LABOUR:-

20. The Contractor shall remain liable for the payment of all wages or other moneys to his work-people or employees under the payment of Wages Act 1936, Employees Liability Act. 1938, Workmen's Compensation Act 1923 or any other Act or enactment, relating thereto and rules framed, thereunder from time to time.

PRECAUTIONS AGAINST RISK:-

21. The Contractor shall be responsible for providing at his own expense for all precautions to prevent loss or damage from any and all risks and to minimize the amount of any such loss or damage and for the necessary steps to be taken for the said purpose.

22. Corrigendum / Amendment:

It is tenderer's responsibility to watch for any corrigendum or amendment till the opening of a particular tender that will be posted only at School web site.

COLUMN LAYOUT PLAN







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














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TOP PLAN OF TRUSS

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
